



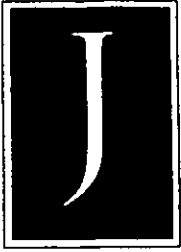

I write this letter in deepest appreciation for the services provided by the program you established of home visits to the elderly / infirmed.




I met Dr. Papanna Ravichandra nine years ago when I was searching for a physician who would conduct home visits for my elderly friend, Vera Contini. I was trying to find an alternative practice with a holistic approach, one that wouldn't hasten hospitalizations and would treat the whole person at home. Dr. Ravichandra judiciously treated her illnesses as they arose, prescribing home visits by therapists and nurses, enabling her to stay in a familiar and comfortable environment. Through his care, Ms. Contini was able to live her days in health and dignity; she died peacefully at home with loved ones nearby at the age of 95.

Currently, Dr. Ravichandra is treating another friend of mine, Lee Anderson, an 89-year-old man who has an intense fear of hospitals. Over the past four years, Dr. Ravichandra has developed a treatment plan for various ailments that included home-based physical therapy and lab testing. For more serious problems, such as a minor stroke, he arranged for Mr. Anderson to be treated on an outpatient basis. 
